The Beechcraft Model 18, or “Twin Beech” as it is better known, is a 6 to 11 seat, twin-engine, low-wing, tail wheel aircraft manufactured by the Beech Aircraft Corporation of Wichita, Kansas. It was originally built for the U.S. Navy and carried Bureau Number (or BuNo) 67161.

BuNo 67161 saw military service during and after World War II in a number of versions, including the U.S. Army Air Forces C-45 Expeditor, AT-7 Navigator, AT-11 Kansan; and for the U.S. Navy, UC-45J Navigator and the SNB-1 Kansan. BuNo 67161 has been on loan to the Air Force Flight Test Museum since 1991.
