REQUEST FOR OVERNIGHT CAMPING AT THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCETM

DAWN PATROL RENDEZVOUS 7-8 OCTOBER 2022



This event is held on a military installation. As such, all participants are subject to federal laws. Permission for overnight camping at the National Museum of the United States Air Force (NMUSAF) will only be granted for preregistered participants of the Dawn Patrol Rendezvous. Participants must read and sign this Request for Overnight Camping. Please return with registration form in enclosed self-addressed envelope.

1) Tent camping and self-contained RVs are permitted only in designated areas.

2) Camping will be permitted beginning the afternoon <u>Wednesday, 5 October 2022</u>. All campers must depart the Museum grounds by 3 p.m. on <u>Sunday, 9 October 2022</u>. Final permitted arrival time will be provided to all campers when parking passes are mailed.

3) All participants must place parking passes in prominent area on the front windshield where it is visible to security personnel. Passes will be mailed to participants in September.

4) Electrical, water, or sewage hook-ups are <u>not</u> available. Generators may be used; please do not create tripping hazards with electrical cords.

5) Open campfires/open flames are strictly prohibited. All campers must have a fire extinguisher.

6) No loud, disruptive or illegal activity is permitted while on the grounds. Guests must stay in the area immediately surrounding their recreational vehicle or tent.

7) All overnight campers must be inside the designated area no later than 11:00 p.m. Gates will lock promptly at 11:00 p.m. each evening. Maps will be provided with designated area and gate entries.

8) In case of emergency from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m., overnight security personnel will be located at the entrance gate.

9) All trash must be cleaned up and removed from camping/RV area prior to departure. No sewage, gray water, etc. is to be disposed on museum grounds.

10) With the exception of service dogs, pets are not permitted in the public event area.

11) Fireworks and firearms, with the singular exception of replica weapons used by re-enactors, are not permitted. All participants and visitors are subject to search.
